He lives in a tree trunk together with his family and friends. His mother, Ms. Shelly, is a teacher, and his father, Mr. Sheldon, is a water collector.




One day Peter goes to school for his classes.

After the classes are over, Ms. Shelly sends Peter to his father to bring him lunch.


Peter crosses the meadow and reaches the Big Rock where Mr. Sheldon is working.





"One day, son, I will teach you how to collect water," he says. "Every drop matters when it's hot outside, and there isn't rain for weeks."


"But, Papa, I don't want to be a water collector," replies Peter. "I want to fly in the sky like a bird!"


"Fly?" Mr. Sheldon exclaims. "But we can't fly. We are snails. We slither."
















